##### Reminder

Lock It Or **LOSE** It

There is an uptick in incidents where unlocked vehicles are being entered in the night time and personal property being stolen

Varsity Lakes recently had 20+ unlocked vehicles entered and there has been an increase in this activity in the neighborhoods around Westminster.

We have two residents, one from Walworth and one from Oxford Ridge reporting their unlocked vehicles were entered into overnight recently.

The Board would like to remind our residents to take steps to minimize the opportunity for criminal activity.

Remove valuables from your vehicle.

Lock your vehicle and close the windows and sun/moon roof

If your vehicle has an alarm make sure you activate it.

Make sure your garage door is closed when unattended.

If possible, leave an exterior light on.

If you "See Something- Say Something", report suspicious activity to the Sheriff's Office (9-1-1 in an emergency or 239-477-1000).

Taking these steps will help keep Westminster safe and will assist in crime prevention.
