#### Important Irrigation Information

The following is an important message concerning irrigation and we ask that you please read it carefully and adhere to its important points.

As we enter the irrigation dry season, pump usage coupled with wells output can put a serious strain on our equipment. Why is this you may ask. It's because many of us are over watering. This will cause costly repair, replacement and/or shut downs unless we adhere to the South Florida Water Management district (SFWMD) watering rules.

Management has recently inspected 60 homes and have found 97% to be watering more than one hour per zone, watering 4 days a week and watering twice a day. Many residents are over watering and wasting valuable water.

Management will inspect and correct all home timers for correct watering days and times. Odd number street addresses are to water on Wednesday and Saturday, while even street address numbers are to water on Thursday and Sunday. Recommended watering times are 25 to 30 minutes for pop up sprinklers and 40 to 45 minutes for rotary sprinklers per zone. EXAMPLE: You have 6 zones and are watering 30 minutes per zone with pop up sprinklers, you will be watering for some 3 hours. This will give you over a half inch of water per

zone. Lawns can only absorb about a half inch of water and anything more will just run off your property carrying your fertilizer with it.

# Please don't change the Management adjustments. Be a good Neighbor!

Another major reason to adhere to the guidelines and to reduce water usage is to limit our liability for damages outside of the community. SFWMD states that for every gallon of water pumped out we must replace a gallon of water back into our ponds. IF we do not replace this water because the wells cannot keep up with the demand and if the wells across the fence (outside our community) dry up, we are liable to replace these wells our expense. SFWMD may also put additional restriction on our usage plus a fine may be levied. IF this occurs our annual dues are likely to increase!

There you have it, an important message about over watering during the dry season. Water is a precious resource and we must all do our part to use this resource responsibly.
