Sheriff's Office 2015 CarFit Program Receives National Recognition

January 2016

For the second consecutive year, the Lee County Sheriff's Office has been nationally recognized by AARP and AAA for their outstanding performance in CarFit, an educational program designed to keep senior drivers safe. The national numbers for 2015 were just released ranking the Sheriff's Office #4 in the nation for the number of CarFit events held last year, and #3 in the nation for the number of participants who took part in those events.

"It is an honor to be recognized for our efforts to enhance driver safety and increase awareness and mobility for our older adults by helping them find the perfect "fit" in their vehicle," said Sheriff Mike Scott. "From start to finish the entire check-up takes less than 20 minutes and is well worth your time."

CarFit is an innovative national program designed to give a quick comprehensive check on how well a senior driver and their vehicle work together while providing tools to understand and apply the safety features of their vehicles. Motorists also receive community traffic resources and information about available adaptive devices that can assist drivers who have mild to moderate physical limitations.
