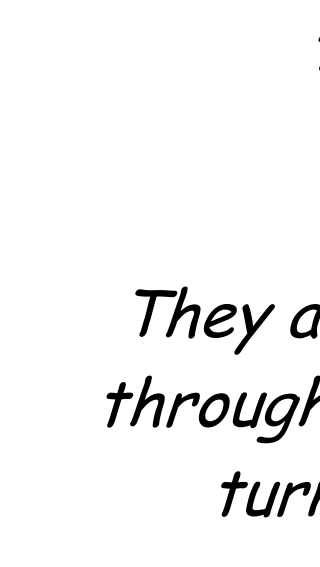

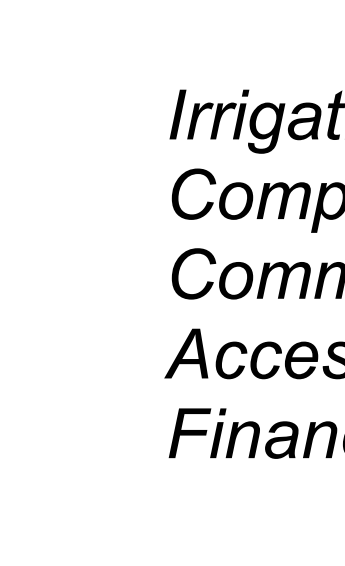
## Irrigation Update
