

FIRST NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING AND ELECTION OF DIRECTORS

TO ALL MEMBERS:

The Annual Meeting of Westminster Community Association, Inc. will be held on the 28th day of March, 2017, at 6:00 p.m., at the Westminster Community Center located at 2001 Oxford Ridge Circle, Lehigh Acres, FL 33973, for the purpose of electing the Board of Directors and such other business as may lawfully be conducted. Subsequent to this FIRST NOTICE, you will receive a SECOND NOTICE OF ANNUAL MEETING. The second notice will specify the meeting agenda and advise you of other important information concerning the Annual Meeting.

The purpose of this FIRST NOTICE is to advise you of the date, time, and place of the Annual Meeting and election of Directors, and to inform you of the process for qualifying for election to the Board of Directors should you wish to become a candidate.

QUALIFYING FOR ELECTION TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

There are ______ seats open for election to the Board of Directors. If you wish to have your name placed on the election ballot, you must deliver written notice to the Association of your desire to run for the Board at least forty-five (45) days before the Annual Meeting (on or before February 13, 2017). Any and all mailed notices of a desire to run for the Board must be addressed to Westminster Community Association, Inc., and mailed to the Association's mailing address at 2001 Oxford Ridge Circle, Lehigh Acres, FL 33973. The enclosed "NOTICE OF INTENT TO BE A CANDIDATE FOR THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS" may be used for that purpose.

In addition, you may submit an optional CANDIDATE INFORMATION SHEET, no larger than 8½ inches by 11 inches. The information provided can contain your qualifications and/or platform for office, but should not exceed one side of the page. The enclosed Candidate Information Sheet may be used for that purpose. The optional Candidate Information Sheet must be submitted to the Association at least forty (40) days before the Annual Meeting (on or before February 16, 2017).

The Candidate Information Sheets and voting ballots will be mailed to the Members at least fourteen (14) days in advance of the date of the Annual Meeting (on or before March 14, 2017).


