September Board Meeting date change. From Sept 15th to Sept 22nd.

Although the Board approved the expenditure for the 2 new pickle ball courts in July, the Board now feels that the cost is very close to our maximum spending limit that we feel it is best to put it to a community vote.

Ballots will go out in the mail to all members with voting rights this week. The votes will be counted at a special members meeting on **Sept 22, 2020 at 6PM at the community center.** The September Board Meeting will follow at 7PM.

Pickle ball is the fastest growing sport in United States and one of the most requested amenities in communities. For those that don't know pickle ball is a game that is somewhat of a mix between tennis, racquetball and ping pong. Players use special paddles and a ball like a Wiffle ball. The court is smaller than a tennis court therefore less strenuous on the knees and legs.

We have many people already playing pickle ball in the community and many more supporting the new courts which will also include a basketball hoop at one end.

A reminder to all that this amenity will not cause any special assessment or an increase in HOA fees. This will be paid from the community resale assessment fund that is there for amenities. Your Board fully supports this new amenity.

We also suggest all members mail in their proxy vote as to minimize in person voting due to continued COVID distancing issues.
